

Racing Association Catamaran Events Switzerland Minutes of the Extraordinary General Assembly Held on June 15th 2018 at 20:00 in Geneva

The General Assembly commences by Kristoffer Jonsson at 20:00 (the president Vinzenz Burgherr apologizes for not being present). The assembly is counting 8 adult active members. Therefore, it can proceed in accordance with the status. Kristoffer greets and thanks the junior members who are also taking part in the assembly.

1. Confirmation of the election of committee and/or new appointments

After discussions with Swiss Sailing, in order to recognise our classes, we need to create an association for each class. The aim of recognition is to have an official Swiss Champion and to be able to vote at the general assembly of Swiss Sailing. A new association will be created only for the Nacra 15 class and the F16 class as there are more than 15 boats which are regularly sailing in each classes. This new organisation means that for each class association, we will keep the same committee as RACES except that the president of the class will change.

RACES will be a hub of classes. In order to have coherence, the presidents of the Nacra 15 class and of the F16 class will enter also in the RACES committee.

The members of the committees are unanimously appointed.

2. Swiss Rating System (SRS)

Swiss Sailing would like all clubs to use Manage2sail. The problem is that with our catamarans, we use the Small Catamaran Handicap Rating System (SCHRS). The idea will be that from 2019, any catamaran owner will be obliged to create his SRS gauge which will have to be paid when creating an SRS account (25 CHF / year). In the future, it will be the only way to race. The committee has not finished the discussions yet (ex: not to charge the CJ).

3. Other matters / questions

The National Nacra 15 will take place on the 29-30 September 2018 at the Yacht Club de Genève (this regatta concerns only the Nacra 15 in order to launch the class). We expect to have around 17 catamarans.

The RACES committee must still think how they will organise the regattas in the future when the Nacra 15 will race with the other C1.

As all the point of the agenda have been discussed of, Kristoffer Jonsson closes the assembly at 20:27.
